Mrs. Glenda Wrenn Inman, beloved wife of Jesse Linton Inman, passed away on December 12, 2015 at Community Hospice House in Vidalia, GA.

Born and raised in Tattnall County as the youngest child of Remer and Annie Findley Wrenn, she was welcomed into the world in 1938 by seven sisters and three brothers. She was a graduate of Collins High School.

The Inmans were married in 1957 in Savannah and would have celebrated their 58th anniversary on December 14. They lived in Savannah and in Chattanooga, TN, Albany, GA, and Montgomery, AL before moving to Lyons about 25 years ago. Residence in Toombs County recognized their mutual heritage, which was pioneered by the Wrenn and Inman families who settled in the area in the early 1800s. They were involved in numerous church and community activities until recent illnesses.

Mrs. Inman was a member of Lyons First United Methodist Church, Sunday School, and the Chancel Choir. She enjoyed singing and appeared in several performances of the folklore play Tales of the Altamaha. She was a member of the Lions Club and the Lyons Merchants Association and was the owner of the infant to toddler clothing and furniture store Baby 2 T's on SE Broad Street in Lyons. She was the former owner and operator of Glenda's Gallery Hallmark Store in Montgomery AL.


