Mr. George B. Chapman Sr., age 78, of Vidalia died Monday evening September 30, 2013 at Community Hospice of Vidalia after a brief illness.

Mr. Chapman was a native of Tattnall County and resided in Vidalia since 1960. He graduated from the University of Georgia as a pharmacist and began his career with Lamars Drugs, later Plaza and Chapman Pharmacy. He was a past president of the Rotary Club and the Chamber of Commerce; he was the 1989 Vidalia Citizen of the Year. He was also a member of and served as a deacon of Vidalia First Baptist Church.
